BUDGET FOR SCHOOLS IS UP \$200,000

Board of Education Adopts an Estimate of \$10,624,393.33 Building Projects Topped Down

A \$10,624,393.33 budget is adopted by the Board of Education yesterday for presentation to City Controller Leonard Leary February 15.

The budget represents an increase of approximately \$200,000 in the estimated expenditures of the schools department during the fiscal year 1937-1938 over those of the present fiscal year.

For Salaries
The chief item of increase, it was explained by Philip Lee Bush, chairman of the Board's Finance Committee, is \$107,000 allocated to increase in teachers' salaries. Improvement to buildings, purchase and repair of textbooks and a variety of other minor items make up the balance.

In making the budget the Board discharged three requests for construction of new buildings. The "Paradise" Park-Union Association ward, immediate construction of a school at Twenty-ninth street and the Longshore Mount Vernon improvement club district a junior high school in the center district.

Wanted School

The board adopted, in informal discussion, a rule against opening school auditoriums to religious discussions. While no controversial discussion was contemplated, the board ruled that to grant such permission would be adverse to the best policy.
