

### CLIFF HOUSE TO BE REOPENED BY NEW FIRM

Famous Resort Leased Under Ten-Year Agreement; Will Be Remodeled

PLANS MADE PUBLIC Restaurant and Entertainment Features Arranged for San Francisco

The Cliff House, San Francisco's famous beach resort, closed for over ten years, will again be opened to the public, according to an announcement yesterday. The plans will be under the management of Richard C. Belmont, one of the owners of "Hotels on the Beach," which has been leased to Belmont to open the building by the fall of 1921. Belmont has secured a ten-year lease with Charles H. Brown, who owns the Cliff House. Belmont will spend \$150,000 for improvements. The Cliff House was originally owned by the late Mrs. J. P. Morgan, who died in 1883. Belmont's father, J. P. Belmont, purchased the property in 1883 for a total cost of \$100,000.
